# User Personas

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User Personas/Audience Definition - personas are fictional characters created to represent the different user types within a targeted demographic, attitude and/or behavior set that might use a site, brand or product in a similar way.

As the first step in developing a user-centric design, a series of representative end-users, or Personae are developed for the Web site. These Personae are tools that enable us to design site features and functionality around user needs. Each Persona includes:

1. Identification: including name, position, age, technology comfort-level
2. Description: job, personality, preferences
3. Long-term objectives and how the Web site will satisfy them
4. List of High Level needs

Personae are not meant to stand in for all potential users of the Web site; rather, they represent a range of user roles and preferences. Moreover, they do not reflect the composite roles that real users often play. The roles are separated to better clarify and categorize user needs. 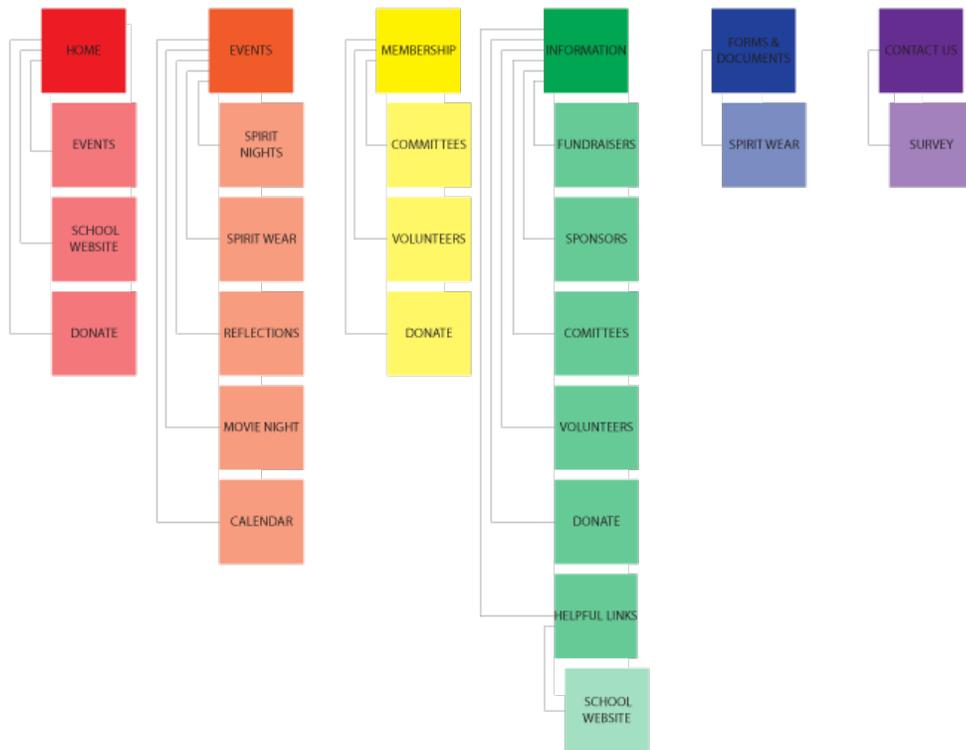
